

Back Roadin' Fall UTV | ATV | Jeep Poker Run - Rules

\$50/hand 5 Card Poker

1. Event will begin at 10am, October 10, 2020. Meet at Brawley Park beginning at 9am. Parking will be provided for trailering guests, locals may wish to ride to the area as parking will be limited.
2. ALL participants must sign a Release of Liability Waiver. This Poker Run is a charitable event and intended for fun for all who participate. This is not a race and there are no prizes for returning first.
3. Entries will be limited, so register early.
4. Each Entry will be given a route directions/map to four (4) locations where a box will be located with sealed envelopes enclosed. As a paid entrant you will take one (1) envelope which will include a card to be revealed to an official at the end of the run.
5. Each paid entrant will collect four (4) envelopes (one from each station) and return back to Brawley Park by 4pm where your envelopes will be opened and your hand revealed. Your final 5th card will be given to you at the park. If you have not visited each station, due to time, a card will be given to you to complete your hand.
6. Envelopes will be sealed, if an envelope is open or a seal is broken, that card is disqualified.
7. Multiple decks of cards will be used during the poker run; at the reveal if you have duplicate cards (2 club Aces, 2-heart 3's, etc), you will discard one of the duplicates and choose an alternate card from an official deck provided.
8. Mulligans will be available for purchase at the end of the run, before you reveal your cards. One mulligan per/hand.
9. The winning hand is determined by standard poker hand rankings. Five cards will be used to build your hand. In the event of a tie hand – a high card will be chosen from an official deck, Ace is high. No 5 of a kind allowed.
10. Winner Poker Hand will receive \$250.00 cash, various door prizes will also be available for FUN!

This is a charitable event, sponsored by the Ellington Chamber of Commerce. All proceeds shall benefit the Ellington Chamber of Commerce.

Poker Entry fee is \$50/hand; entry includes an event t-shirt, route directions/maps and poker hand. If you are not playing a poker hand, we remind you NOT to take a envelope at the card stations.

Backroad Pass/entry fee is \$25.00; entry includes event t-shirt, route directions/maps and chance to win prizes.

Our Fall UTV ride will happen – rain or shine! No refunds.

Reynolds County requires slow moving vehicle sign (triangle) and a permit. Permits are \$10 and will be valid for 2020 & 2021, you will need to contact the Reynolds County Courthouse for your permit. Contact them by email at reynolds@sos.mo.gov or 573.649.2494 (#9, ext #1). They will need your Name, Address, Make, Model, Year and VIN for you vehicle. Reynolds County will send you a permit. Or if you prefer you can stop by the Sheriff's office at any time and get a permit.

Poker Hand Rankings (highest to lowest)

| | |
|------------------|--------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| Royal Flush: | Run of sequential cards from ten to Ace with all cards of the same suit. |
| Straight Flush: | Run of sequential cards all cards in the same suit, but <i>not</i> Ace high |
| Four of a Kind: | Four cards of the same rank e.g. four Aces, four Kings etc. |
| Full House: | Three cards of the same rank plus a pair, e.g. three Aces and a pair of Kings. |
| Flush: | Five cards of the same suit. |
| Straight (Run): | Five sequential cards, not of the same suit. |
| Three of a Kind: | Three cards of the same rank e.g. three Aces, three Kings, etc. |
| Two Pair: | Two sets of pairs e.g. a pair of Aces and a pair of Kings. |
| Pair: | Two cards of the same rank, e.g. two Aces, two Kings etc. |
| High Card: | If you have none of the above, then the highest value card in your hand. |

Notes:

Aces count high for all hands e.g. a pair of Aces beats a pair of Kings

In a straight an Ace can count low (e.g. A,2,3,4,5) OR high (10,J,Q,K A) but **NOT BOTH** (e.g.Q,K,A,2,3 if NOT a straight).

If any card drawn is a duplicate of a card previously drawn, that card must be re-drawn. No hand can have duplicate cards (e.g. you cannot have more than one King of Hearts in your hand).

Prizes are awarded on the poker hand rankings outlined above, not on speed. ***We want all participants to have fun and remain safe, so please take your time on the run.***
