\$50/hand 5 Card Poker

1. Ride will leave at 10am, May 15, 2021. **Meet at 342 CR 776 off B Hwy at 9am (field)**. Parking will be provided for trailering guests.
2. ALL participants must sign a Release of Liability Waiver. This Poker Run & Ride is a charitable event and intended for fun for all who participate. This is not a race and there are no prizes for returning first.
3. **Entries will be limited**, so register early.
4. Each Entry will be given a route directions/map. Instructions for the Poker Run will be given before the event starts at the start location.
5. All entries return back to the starting point by 4pm where your envelopes will be opened and your hand revealed. Your final 5th card will be given to you at the start point. If you have not visited each station, due to time, a card will be given to you to complete your hand.
6. Multiple decks of cards will be used during the poker run; at the reveal if you have duplicate cards (2 club Aces, 2-heart 3's, etc), you will discard one of the duplicates and choose an alternate card from an official deck provided.
7. Mulligans will be available for purchase at the end of the run, before you reveal your cards.
8. The winning hand is determined by standard poker hand rankings. Five cards will be used to build your hand. In the event of a tie hand – a high card will be chosen from an official deck, Ace is high. No 5 of a kind allowed.
9. Winner Poker Hand will receive the Grand Prize; various door prizes will also be available for FUN!

This is a charitable event, sponsored by the Ellington Chamber of Commerce. All proceeds shall benefit the Ellington Chamber of Commerce.

Poker Entry fee is \$50/hand; entry includes an event t-shirt, route directions/maps and poker hand. If you are not playing a poker hand, we remind you NOT to take an envelope at the card stations.

Backroad Pass/entry fee is \$25.00; entry includes event t-shirt, route directions/maps and chance to win prizes.

Our ride will happen – rain or shine! No refunds.

Shannon County requires slow moving vehicle sign (triangle) and a permit. Permits are \$15 and will be valid for as long as you own that SXS. You will need to contact the Shannon County Courthouse for your permit. Contact the Clerk by phone at 573-226-3315 (ex #1). They will need your Name, Address, Make, Model, Year and VIN for your vehicle. Shannon County will mail you a permit. If you contact them late and you do not have time to receive your permit in the mail they can send you verification of your permit via email.

Poker Hand Rankings (highest to lowest)

| | |
|------------------|--|
| Royal Flush: | Run of sequential cards from ten to Ace with all cards of the same suit. |
| Straight Flush: | Run of sequential cards all cards in the same suit, but <i>not</i> Ace high |
| Four of a Kind: | Four cards of the same rank e.g. four Aces, four Kings etc. |
| Full House: | Three cards of the same rank plus a pair, e.g. three Aces and a pair of Kings. |
| Flush: | Five cards of the same suit. |
| Straight (Run): | Five sequential cards, not of the same suit. |
| Three of a Kind: | Three cards of the same rank e.g. three Aces, three Kings, etc. |
| Two Pair: | Two sets of pairs e.g. a pair of Aces and a pair of Kings. |
| Pair: | Two cards of the same rank, e.g. two Aces, two Kings etc. |
| High Card: | If you have none of the above, then the highest value card in your hand. |

Notes:

Aces count high for all hands e.g. a pair of Aces beats a pair of Kings

In a straight an Ace can count low (e.g. A,2,3,4,5) OR high (10,J,Q,K,A) but *NOT BOTH* (e.g. Q,K,A,2,3 if NOT a straight).

If any card drawn is a duplicate of a card previously drawn, that card must be re-drawn. No hand can have duplicate cards (e.g. you cannot have more than one King of Hearts in your hand).

Prizes are awarded on the poker hand rankings outlined above, not on speed. **We want all participants to have fun and remain safe, so please take your time on the run.**
